It is hard to believe that a chance remark by a member of the village started Fulford Community Choir and that we are now celebrating our tenth anniversary! In these ten years the choir has given annual Christmas and afternoon tea concerts to a packed village hall, taken part in competitions in Leicester and Nuneaton, sung in Sandon Hall and the Victoria Hall several times and most recently in Lichfield Cathedral. It has of course been a challenging couple of years but thanks to the unwavering enthusiasm and energy of the conductor, Dan Hollingshurst and Zoom - the choir is still singing and is now returning to full strength.

To celebrate 'Ten Years of Song' the choir will be hosting an afternoon of music at Sandon Hall on 12th June starting at 2.00pm where there will be the opportunity to picnic in the beautiful grounds with music from Fulford musicians (including children from the Primary School) throughout the afternoon.
